Netaji Subhas Ashram Mahavidyalaya : A Profile

Netaji Subhas Ashram Mahavidyalaya is located at Suisa of Bagmundi block of south-western fringe of Purulia district. The Suisa is in the midst of tribal and other indigenous groups of people and obviously in the very heart of rich ancient Jain civilization. The college is located at 23° 11' 22" N latitude and 86 49' 11" E longitude. According to structure and landform, Suisa is a part of the Chhotanagpur plateau. Its general elevation is 218 meter above mean sea level. Suisa enjoys sub-tropical climate and is characterized by high evaporation and low precipitation. The average annual rainfall in this place is 134 cm. But rainfalls are uneven, scanty and erratic with much concentration during monsoon months. July is the rainiest month. The relative humidity is high in monsoon season, being 75 per cent to 85 per cent. But in hot summer it comes down to 25 per cent to 35 per cent. The maximum temperature in this place rarely goes beyond 46° C, whereas minimum temperature rarely goes below 8° C. May is the hottest month and January is the coldest month in this place.

Suisa is just 26 km from Jhalda town and 83 km from Purulia city. This place is connected with other places of West Bengal as well as of India by SH 32 and other roads and SE Railway line. But unfortunately even today the communication system of this area is very poor. The railway line which runs just after the college gate is totally useless for the students. Few buses ply from Bagmundi or from Jhalda to Suisa. This is the only degree college in the Block. Started its journey on the auspicious day of 28th August, 1985, with a view to spread higher education opportunities for the native people of this remote area with only 43 students. Since then it has been firmly on its mission to fulfill the vision set by the requirements of the area. Lack of infrastructural facilities and prevalence of backwardness are the only hindrance to the growth of education system in the area. In spite of that, within a short span of time, the college enjoying an enviable position in the field of education of the district. From its inception, the educational level of this college is satisfactory. So many students passed from this college established their position in different fields.

It is a co-educational degree college affiliated to the Sidho Kanho Birsha University and also recognized under section 2f and 12-B of the University Grants Commission Act-1956. It offers courses in a wide range of disciplines. The institute is the first to introduce Chhou dance and Mask making as C. O. P. course sponsored by UGC.

The institute is an island of greenery within locality. The campus is full of beautiful trees and flowers. The campus harbors both exotic and indigenous plant species with about 50 species of plant. The total area of the college campus is 6.59 acre. The college runs with 7 departments, two common rooms, one hostel, an enriched library, a reading room, an assembly hall, two laboratories, and a guest house. In front of the main building and just immediate behind the main gate a noble statue of Netaji is erected.

Aims and Objectives:

The College caters to the need of the large section of economically and educationally Backward Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe students especially for the women for higher education. Besides of the above, the College endeavors to:

Strengthen the extension education services to the society.

Achieve all round development of the Students in this backward region of Purulia.

Engineer the process of social development in accordance with local needs and demands.

Help the youth to earn their first degree.

Enable the youth to serve the Society better by promoting the ideas of fraternity and national integration.

Create a zeal among the students to gride the society to a better future.

Create Visionaries of the future.

Courses offered :

2. UGC approved Career Oriented Programme: (COP)

Other than the above mention subjects a students can take their admission in UGC approved Certificate course on Chhau Dance and Mask Making. Only 50 students can take admission in this course.

Application Form:

As per the order of the Higher Education department, govt. of West Bengal, admission of the college will be on On-line basis. The process will start soon.

The college prospectus can be downloaded from college website.

Eligibility Criteria for admission to degree Honours and General Course:-

Application must have passed at least in five subjects with English and Environmental students as compulsory subjects in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination recognized by the Board/University.

Candidates applying for Honours Course require 55% of marks in the aggregate or 50% marks in the aggregate with 60% marks in the subject applying for Honours at the H.S or equivalent examination.

For S.C/S.T candidates, the minimum marks for eligibility shall be 45% in the aggregate with 50 % in the Honours subject.

There are no marks barrier to take admission in pass course.

The following documents must be produced in original at the time of Verification after on-line admission:-

1. Original Mark sheet of H.S (10+2) or its equivalent examination.
2. Caste certificate.
3. Character Certificate & Leaving Certificate from the head of the Institution last attended. (non refundable)
4. Migration certificate (only by the candidates coming from boards other than West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education).
5. M.P Admit Card.
6. Adhar Card .

Co –curricular Activities of the College:

Apart from the educational activities this seat of education has stretched its hand to other co-curricular activities. These are:

1. Students Union :

College Students Union is formed by the students of the College every year as per norms of the University of Sidho-Kanho- Birsha . The students Union conducts Game and Sports, Cultural Programmes, Publication of yearly College Magazine, Annual Social Function etc. every year successfully.

2. Nation Service Scheme (N.S.S.):-

The college has one Nation Service Scheme unit. This unit conducts AIDS Awareness Programme, Health awareness Programme, Pulse Polio Immunization Programme, Blood Donation Camp, 7days Special Camp with literacy and Sanitation Campaign and Community surveys in adopted villages under the commendable supervision of Concerned Programme Officer.

Facilities:

1. Availability of Digital Classroom only for Hons' Students.
2. Well equipped Library with Computer facility and Internet Connectivity.

3. Student Amenities:

Pure drinking water with cooling facility /Girls Common room with Indoor Game facility.

4. 24 hours Electric facility.

5. Remedial coaching class for SC/ST students:

With the objective of fulfilling the long standing need of the students belong to SC/ST category, the UGC has approved Remedial Coaching Class for those backward community students to catch up with the rest.

6. Half Free Studentship:

A good number of poor but meritorious students are awarded half free studentship. No such facilities are allowed to SC/ST students.

7. **Government Scholarship:**

Students belong to SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/Minority are required to apply through the Principal for stipend & scholarships.

8. **Library:**

Students are provided with day issue card for the reading room of the library and no transferable borrower's card to take out books at a time for a week.

9. **Parking:** -staff and students parking facilities available.

10. **Canteen:** Students and staff canteen is in the premises.

11. **Common Room :** Boys and Girls common Room is in the college.

12. **Railways/Bus Concession:** Railways /Bus Concession will be issued to the regular student to go their home town.

13. **Computer Lab:-**

Computer dept. Provides the students with a modern and well equipped lab. Internet facilities will be installed in this session. The Lab is run by WEBEL Informatics Department. Govt. of West Bengal Under taking.

14. **Anti Ragging Committee:** There is an anti ragging committee as per UGC guideline in this college.

College Rules & Regulation :

1. Students by the very first day of joining the College are observe and follow its rules, regulations and traditions.
